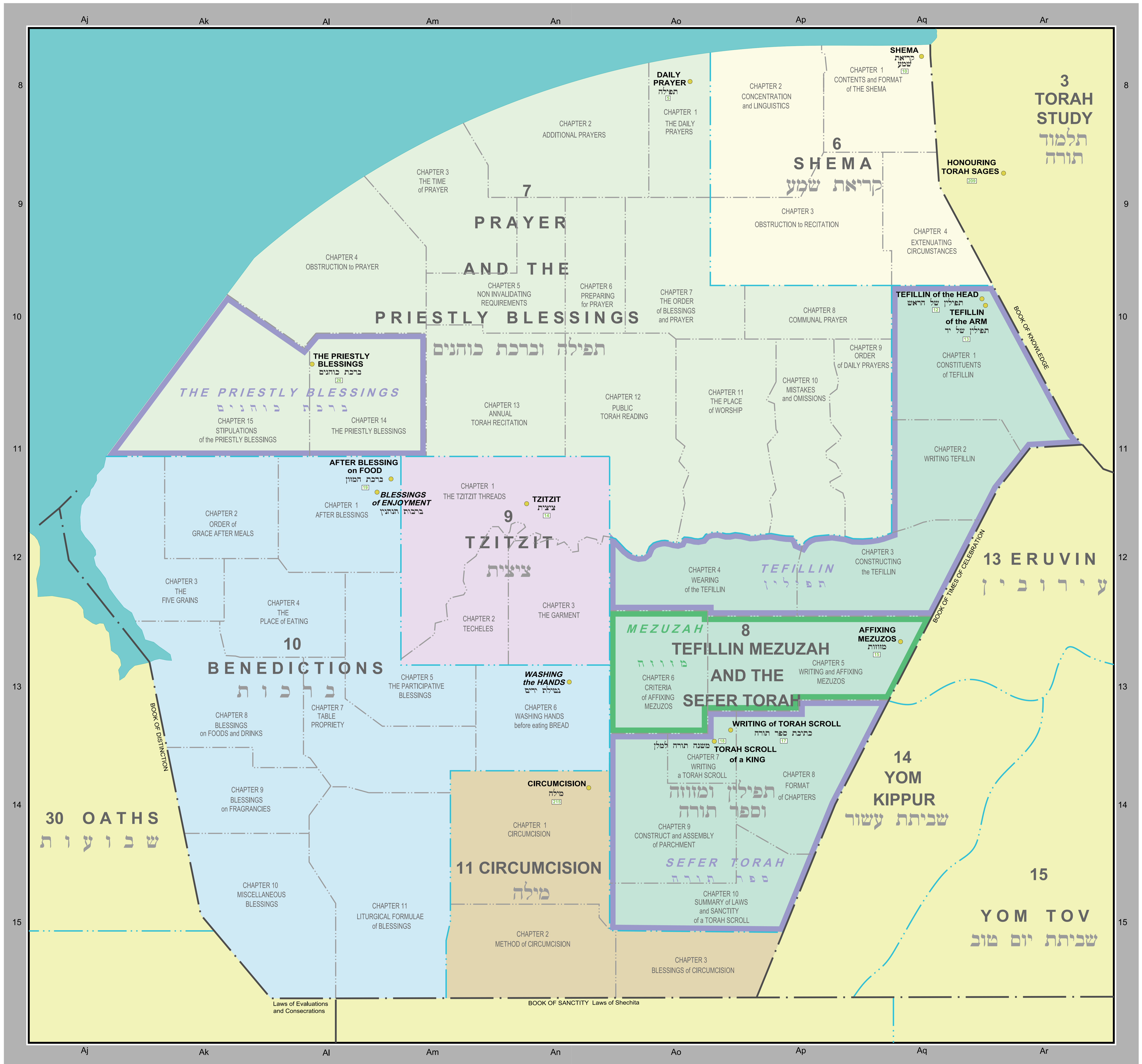

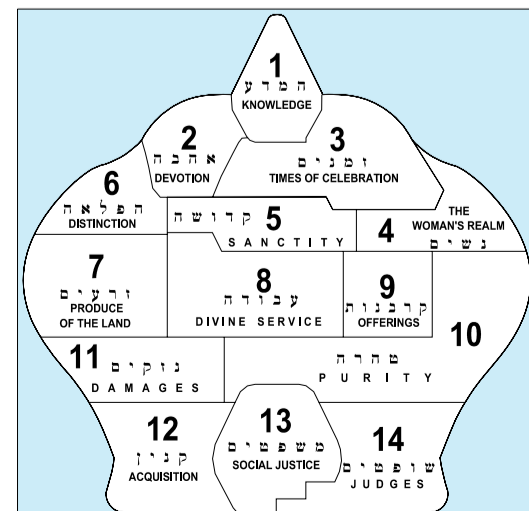
## INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

"Torah Map" is a visual subject guide to the Mishnah Torah of the Rambam. In his introduction to the Mishnah Torah, the Rambam presents his codification of the entire body of Torah Law, halakot, by subject, in a descending order of detail. This order comprises of fourteen books, eighty-three Hilchot (laws). One hundred chapters and numerous smaller halakot (individual laws or rulings). "Torah Map" portrays the content and order of the Mishnah Torah in a spatial or "geographic" relationship.

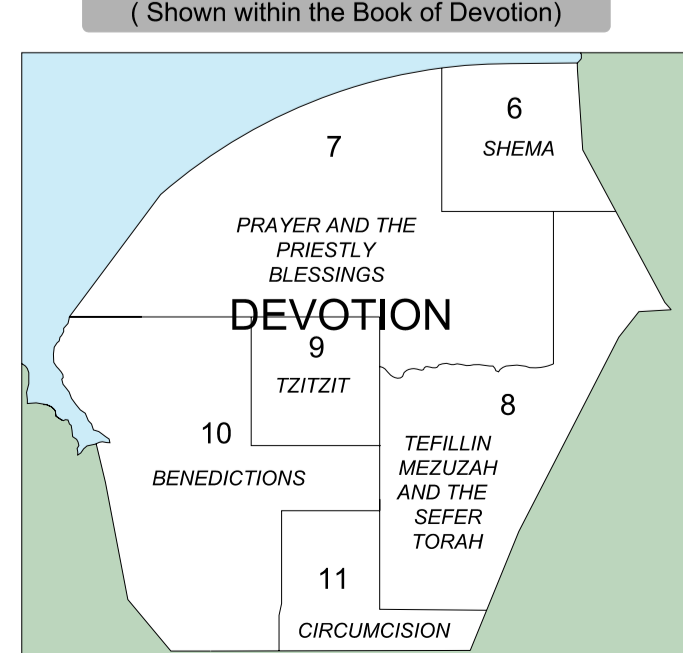
## AREA, SHAPES AND SIZES

The shaded areas of the "Torah Map" depict the relative sizes of the books of the Mishnah Torah as well as the Hilchot of the Mishnah Torah according to the number of chapters. Hence the larger the area the more chapters are contained therein.

## HILCHOT (Shown within the Book of Devotion)



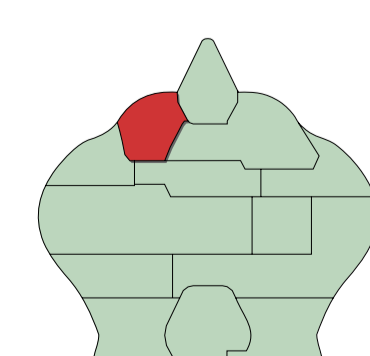
## DIVISIONS
